Policy on having a concession booth during the Annual Clay County Pioneer Reunion

In the past, school groups, civic clubs & organizations, and church groups have been allowed to set up "booths" to sell their items as fund raisers with 20% of the net proceeds going to the Clay County Pioneer Association. However, because of the increased interest in doing this and in order to be fair to everyone, the Nine-Man Board has set the following policy.

Each group must sell something different and will be limited to two specific items. This should make it fair for everyone to have a chance to make money for their group. (as of 2011, everyone will be allowed to sell water – due to the heat and size of the crowds).

Each group must have their request approved by the Nine-Man Board. The Nine-Man Board meets on the second Monday night of each month and every Monday night after the second Monday in August until after the Reunion. Please call the rodeo office, 538-5111 or Cinda Seabourn, 733-1882 to make sure your group's request has been approved.

Announcements for the parade announcers will be made from the approved request forms. It is important to fill out what and when you will be selling.

Space and electrical outlets are limited. It is our policy that if your group has had a concession in previous years, you keep your spot and outlets. Newcomers are to make their own arrangements for space and electricity.

Attached is a report to be filled out, for everyone's convenience. If at all possible, reports should be turned in to the rodeo office on the Monday following the reunion. Checks are to be made out to the Clay County Pioneer Association for 20% of the profit after all expenses are deducted from the sales. If unable to have the report in to the rodeo office by the following Monday, reports may be mailed to Clay County Pioneer Association, P.O. Box 4, Henrietta, Texas 76365.
